HEALTH EFFECTIVENESS DATA INFORMATION SET

HEDIS is a set of data collected from health plans who provide services for commercial, Medicare, Medicaid and health exchange enrollees.

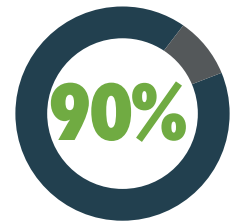
As one component of the **National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA)** accreditation process, it is increasingly used to track year-to-year performance. HEDIS results are an indicator of how well participating health plans deliver care to their members.
